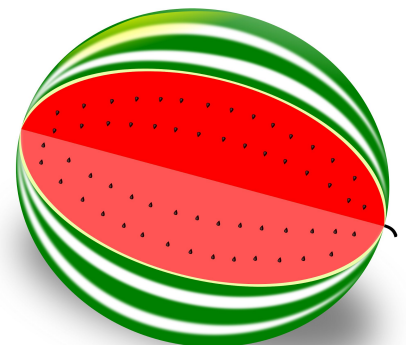
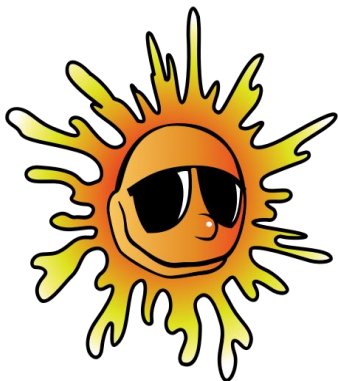

In 2023, Region 1 asked 7th-12th graders to take a voluntary and confidential survey; 76% of students participated. Teachers and providers now use these insights daily.

HOW MANY STUDENTS HAVE EXPERIENCED ANXIETY?

1 in 4 students in grades 7-12 always, or almost always, experience anxiety



WHAT ARE THE MOST COMMON SOURCES OF STRESS?

The most frequently reported sources of stress are academics, peers, schedule, and post-high school plans.

HOW MUCH DOES ANXIETY IMPACT REGION 1 YOUTH?

Almost 30% of youth in grades 7 through 12 report that anxiety makes things in their life difficult "always" or "almost always".

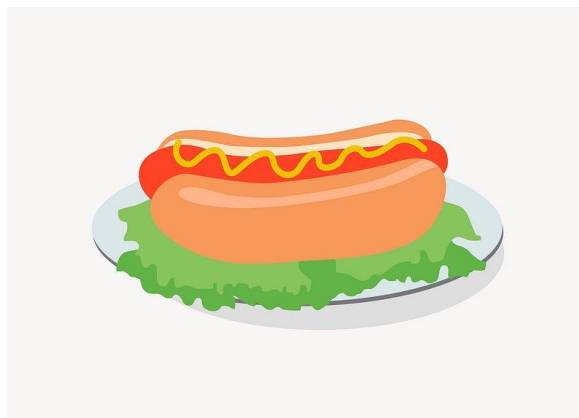

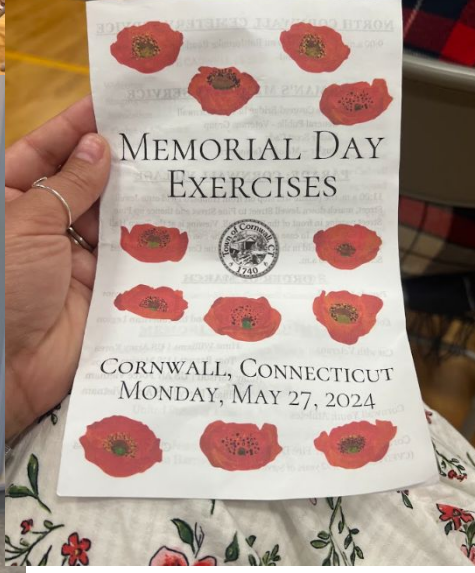
