

James. Learn how a struggling young boy goes on to become one of the greatest basketball players of all time.




Learn about Justice Jackson's childhood and the journey she took to become the first Black woman to serve on the Supreme Court.

March 7, 2025

We will be holding a Read-A-Thon on March 7th to reinforce the importance of reading while also doing something to help those in need. This will be the culminating event of our Read Across America Week at CCS.

The proceeds from our Read-A-Thon will be used to help a school in California affected by the devastating wildfires experienced this year.

Please help your child collect donations or pledges prior to the event. Donation/pledge forms will be due by March 7<sup>th</sup> so that we can share with students and families at the end of the event how much we raised. If a pledger would like to pay by minute, K- will read for 20 min, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders will read for 30 minutes, 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will read for 40 minutes, 4<sup>th</sup> graders will read for 50 minutes, and 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders will read for 60 minutes.

We would like to invite parents to share in the joy of reading with us! Parents can come in and set up a cozy reading space for them and their student(s) starting at 1:45. The event will end at 2:55 giving students a chance to go back to their classrooms and collect their belongings. Children being transported home by parents from the event can return to the gym to meet their families at dismissal time.
