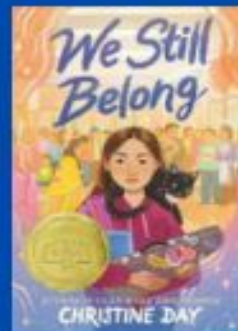

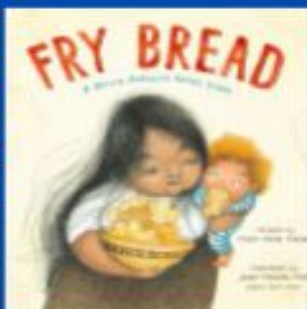

#### 6-8 BOOK



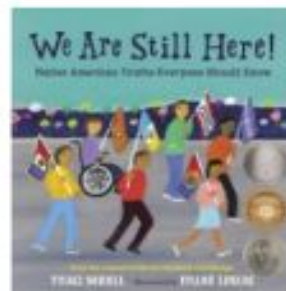

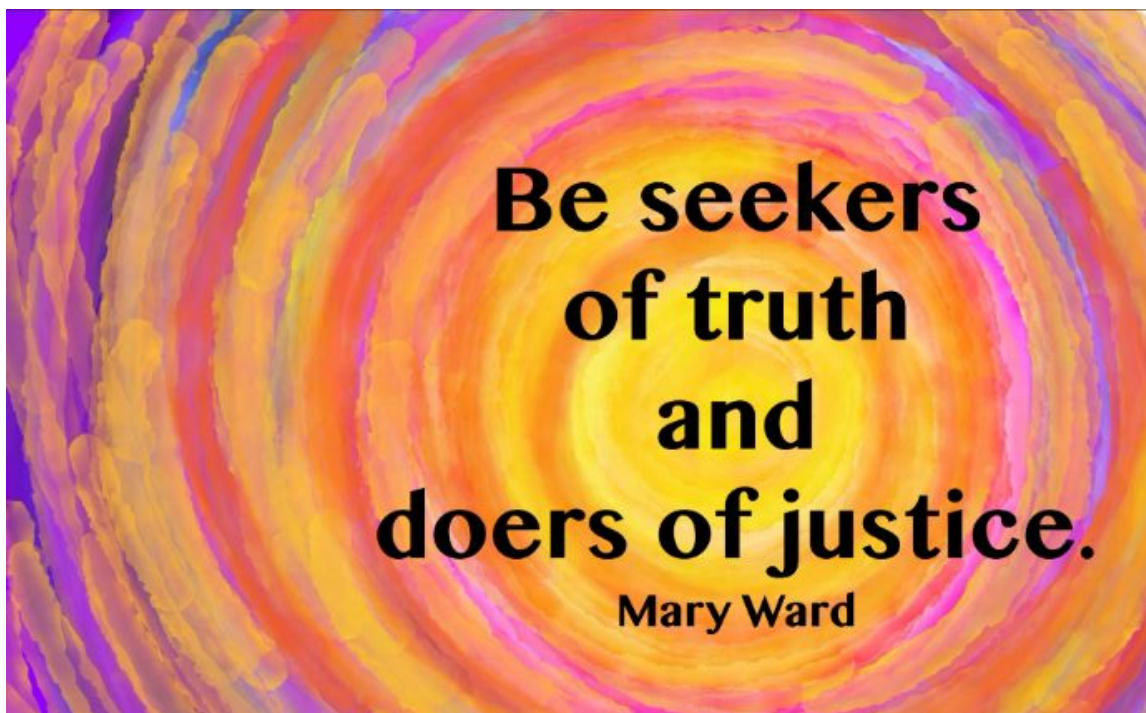

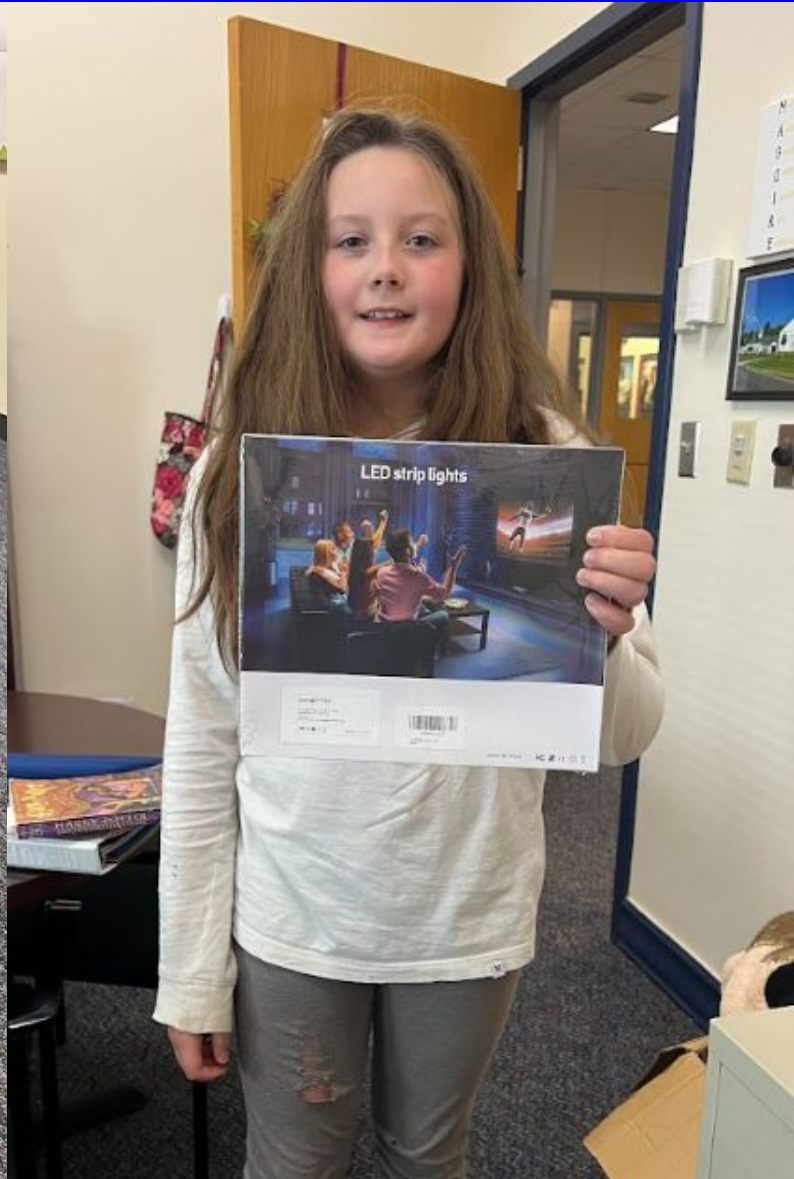
