


#### TRADITIONS AROUND THE GLOBE


This month in the library, we will be learning about traditions and holidays celebrated around the globe through literature and research. Come check out these books at the library!


In this book you can learn the science behind the winter solstice and also about the traditions and history of how the shortest day has been celebrated around the
